And the Trophy for Best Single Malt Under 12 Years in 1997, 1999, 2001 and 2002.

Not to mention the Trophy as Best Single Malt Over 12 Years, awarded to the Distillers Edition, also in 2002.

Easy to enjoy yet, like Skye itself, hard to leave, Talisker draws acclaim from far and near. One taste will tell you why.
