Her creations have inspired the latest short film Coral Clear that has received many prestigious awards including Cannes World Film Festival. By using her Amazigh heritage, the designer manages to translate traditional North African fashions into luxurious evening and bridal wear.

Patricia Caicedo is a soprano, a musicologist and a physician whose scholarship and performances center around Latin American and Iberian art song. She has released eleven albums and published numerous scholarly editions of scores and books, including *The Latin American Art Song: Sounds of the Imagined Nations* and *We are what we listen to: the impact of music on individual and social health*.

She has performed around the world in addition to founding and directing the Barcelona Festival of Song. Patricia holds a Ph.D. in musicology from the Universidad Complutense de Madrid and a Medical Doctor's degree from the Escuela Colombiana de Medicina.
