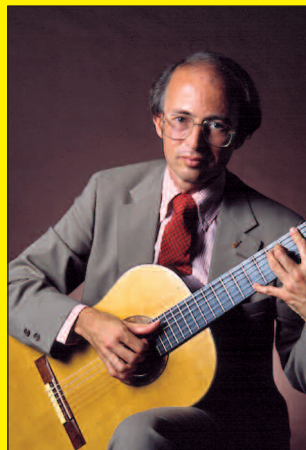

Born in Sao Paulo, Brazil, Barbosa-Lima began playing the guitar at the age of 7. He studied with Isaias Savio and Andres Segovia and has taken the instrument to new levels. Carlos' first concert with LACCS was entitled "Gentle Genius of the Guitar", held at the Wigmore Hall on 16th October 1989, a concert given in the presence of H.E. Senhor Synesio Sampaio Goes Filho, then Ambassador of the Embassy of Brazil.

Other memorable performances were the concerts given with the Wren Orchestra, with guests Laurindo Almeida and Thiago de Mello, (3rd April 1992) St. John's Smith Square, *A Tribute to Laurindo Almeida* with guest Charlie Byrd (28th May 1996), Purcell Room, SBC, *The Best of Brazilian Music* with the English Chamber Orchestra, soloist CBL, conducted by Nelson Nirenberg (5th December 1997), SJSS, *Saudade do Brasil*, again with the ECO, soloist CBL, conducted by Simon Wright (11th May 2004), QEH, just to mention some of them. Now we are celebrating his 50 years on the stage.
